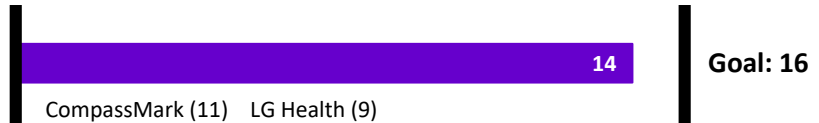


Goal 1: Strengthen evidence-based prevention and interventions

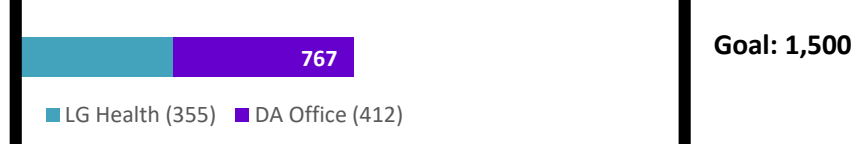
1.1 Increase the number of school districts offering an evidence-based prevention program from 13 to 16.



1.2 Increase the number of drop-off sites for unused medications from 29 to 31.



1.3 Distribute 1,500 naloxone kits to first responders, pharmacies, primary care, and community organizations.

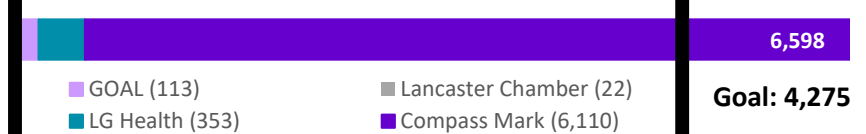


Goal 2: Continue to share common messages throughout the community

2.1 Distribute 50,000 Joining Forces materials with unified, consistent messages about opioids (*revised 6/19*).



2.2 Reach 4,275 community members at community/professional education events.



2.3 Exceed 6,000,000 media/website impressions through the countywide media campaign.

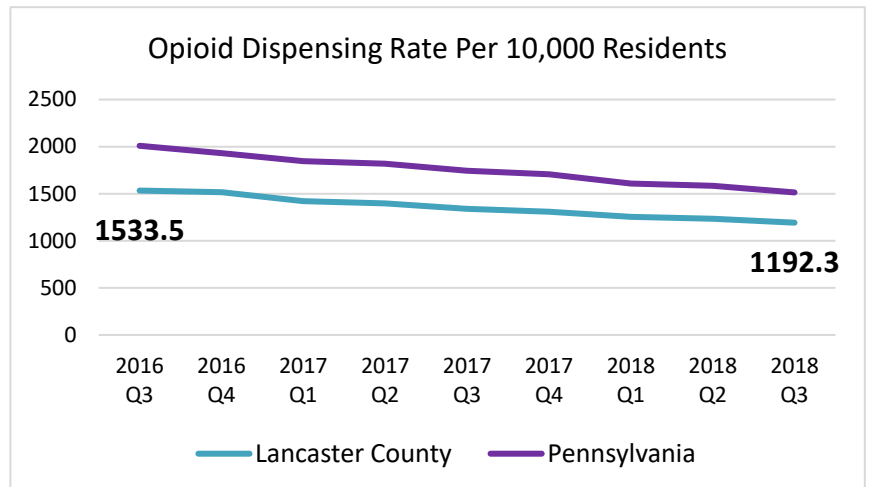


2.4 Exceed 1,500 new visitors to the Joining Forces website each quarter.



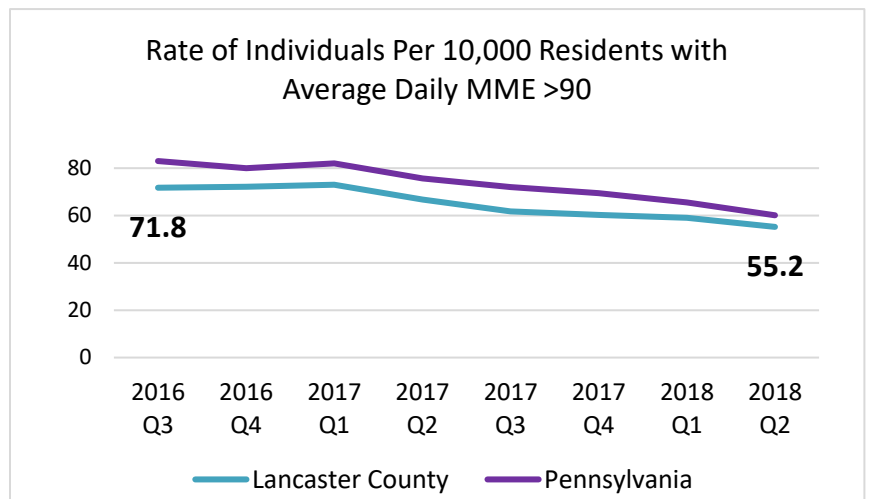
Goal 3. Create lasting changes in the medical community that improve patient safety

3.1 Reduce the rate of opioids dispensed per 10,000 residents in Lancaster County.

3.2 Reduce the rate of individuals with average daily MME > 90 per 1,000 population.

3.3 Establish a baseline for the percentage of patients with indications for naloxone who are prescribed naloxone.

3.4 Establish a baseline measure of collaboration among health systems to address the opioid crisis.

Data collection in progress, June 28-July 19.

Goal 4. Increase treatment & recovery support services

4.1 Add 6 drug & alcohol case managers to the treatment system.

On July 1, 2019, six outpatient clinics were given funding by the Lancaster County D&A Commission to hire fulltime case managers. They are all in the process of hiring staff.

4.2 Evaluate feasibility of creating a halfway house and a recovery house for women with children.

Both the halfway house and the recovery house for women with children have been funded with HealthChoices start up grants for this region, and requests for proposals have been released. The first attempts to hire an agency for each project failed, so the proposals are being distributed to a greater number of agencies in the state.
