

## WHAT IS NARCAN?

NARCAN is one type of naloxone, a life-saving medication that can reverse the effects of an opioid overdose. It's a nasal spray that is designed to be easy to use.

## HOW DO I GET NARCAN?

You can get NARCAN at most pharmacies with or without a prescription from your doctor. In Pennsylvania, there is a public standing order that allows pharmacies to distribute NARCAN to anyone. It is covered by most insurances, usually with a low copay.
