

# Annual Overdose Deaths in Lancaster County, 2013-present



Drug-Induced Death Rates Per 100,000 People, 2011-2021 (Source: CDC WONDER)






Past 12-Month Counts of Overdose Deaths by Month (Lancaster County)




### Drug Overdose Deaths, Pennsylvania






## Substances Found in Lancaster County OD Deaths (% of deaths)



#### Overdose Death Rate per 10,000 by Age




### Overdose Death Rate per 10,000 by Race/Ethnicity





## Summary

- A total of 105 overdose deaths occurred in Lancaster County in 2022.
   Overdose deaths in Lancaster County have doubled since 2013, but have decreased from higher levels in 2017 and 2020-2021.
- Death rates from overdoses are lower in Lancaster County than in the U.S. and in Pennsylvania overall.
- Emergency room visits for all drug overdoses and naloxone administration by EMS declined in 2022 compared with 2020 and 2021.
- Fentanyl causes nearly 9 out of 10 overdose deaths in Lancaster County.
- The age groups 25-34, 35-44, and 45-54 are at the highest risk for overdose.
- Males have a higher rate of overdose deaths than females.
- Death rates are disproportionately high among Black and Latino individuals.
  There was a 28% decrease in the number of deaths among white individuals
  from 2021 to 2022, but no change in the number of deaths among Black
  individuals or Latino individuals.
